# **Resolution to Support an Administrative response to the Campaign for Students**

Whereas, a group of Undergraduates have come together as the Campaign for Students highlighting a prior trend of administrative decisions regarding student life seeming not to consider student input and seeking to make the administration's decision-making process more transparent to students and urge the administration to be more accountable to students for the decisions they make about student life; and

Whereas, on Oct 17th the Campaign for Students staged a "tool in" in Lobby 7 as a protest of the administration's "chronic disregard" for student feedback in their decision making process; and

Whereas, the UA is not affiliated with the Campaign for Students.

### **Be it resolved, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:**

That the Undergraduate Association urges the administration to continue to find ways to involve students when making decisions pertaining to undergraduate life; and

That the Undergraduate Association continues to strongly support transparency and accountability in administrative decision making process; and

That the undergraduate Association supports discussion and evaluation of matters brought forward by the Campaign for Students to be discussed directly in the Taskforce for Student Engagement.
