Resolution to Improve Executive Branch Communication of Bill Execution

Be it resolved, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:

That each piece of legislation, wherever possible, be geared toward a specific officer or committee of the Undergraduate Association who will be responsible for executing the legislation; and

That the officer or committee chair responsible for the legislation updates other members of the Undergraduate Association on the progress of the legislation's implementation upon request.
