



## **40 U.A.S. 6.3 Bill to Reimburse Rune**

Whereas, Rune is an ASA-recognized student group that produces MIT's official literary and arts magazine, *Rune*; and

Whereas, *Rune*, receives hundreds of submissions from members of the MIT community and publishes work from approximately 50 authors and artists every year; and

Whereas, in Spring 2008, Finboard allocated Rune \$2,000, which was spent in May 2008; and

Whereas, Rune tried to get reimbursed, but was unaware that any expenditure exceeding \$5000 requires the submission of a purchase order; and

Whereas, Rune acted to resolve this matter promptly, but was unable to submit the new reimbursement paperwork before the term had ended and the account had closed;

### **Be it enacted, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:**

That Senate immediately allocate \$2,000 from the Senate Discretionary Fund to reimburse Rune.
