Bill to Reform the Role of UA Secretary-General

Whereas the Secretary-General attends all major internal Undergraduate Association meetings;
and

Whereas the UA is working to increase its transparency to students; and

Whereas the UA website is rarely updated with relevant information; and

Whereas the UA suffers from a major lack of institutional memory;

Be it enacted, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:

That Article V Section 4 Sub-section a of the Executive Committee Bylaws now read “The Secretary-General shall act as Secretary for both the Senate and the Cabinet. In this role, the Secretary-General shall be responsible for facilitating communications between the internal bodies of this Association as well as external organizations as determined by the President. Likewise, the Secretary-General shall be entrusted with ensuring the timely recording and dispersing of Undergraduate Association minutes and notices, such as working with the Chair of the Communications Committee to put Senate summaries in the Tech.”; and

That Article V Section 4 Sub-section b of the Executive Committee Bylaws now read “The Secretary-General shall work with the History Committee in maintaining the archival records of the Undergraduate Association”; and

That Article V Section 4 Sub-section e of the Executive Committee Bylaws be created to read “The Secretary-General shall be responsible for working with the History and Communications Committees”; and

That Article V Section 4 Sub-section f of the Executive Committee Bylaws be created to read “The Secretary-General shall ensure that the content of the UA website remains current.”.
