# Bill to Temporarily Suspend Minimum Meeting Interval Requirement

Whereas Article IV, Section 4, Subsection 1 of the Senate Bylaws state that “nor shall fewer than seven calendar days separate meetings of the Senate”; and

Whereas the second and third meetings of UAS 41 are currently scheduled for October 13 and October 19, six calendar days apart; and

Whereas the meeting on October 13 was originally scheduled for October 12, but was moved to October 13 when more than a majority of Senate members indicated that October 13 was a better date for the meeting, due to the Columbus Day holiday and other concerns; and

Whereas it is the feeling of the Senate that this pattern of scheduling does not significantly deviate from the spirit of the Bylaws; and

Whereas resolving this discrepancy swiftly is necessary to avoid further altering the Senate schedule;

**Be it enacted, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:**

That the Senate formally suspend Article IV, Section 4, Subsection 1 of the Senate Bylaws regarding the scheduling of the October 13 and October 19 meetings.
