# Bill to Decrease the Minimum Meeting Interval Requirement

Whereas Article IV, Section 4, Subsection 1 of the Senate Bylaws state that “nor shall fewer than seven calendar days separate meetings of the Senate”; and

Whereas Senate meetings may conceivably need to be held one day before or after their usual dates to avoid holidays; and

Whereas such a schedule may place two Senate meetings only six calendar days apart from one another; and

Whereas such temporary disruptions should be allowed to occur without disrupting the Senate schedule for the rest of the term;

**Be it enacted, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:**

That the Senate Bylaws be amended as follows:

- Article IV, Section 4, Subsection 1 of the Senate Bylaws shall read: “nor shall fewer than ~~seven~~ **six** calendar days separate meetings of the Senate”
