Resolution to Continue Transparency and Representation throughout the Institute-wide Planning Process

Whereas undergraduates will be affected by a significant portion of the final Institute-wide budget cuts; and

Whereas undergraduates appreciate a growing level of involvement in Institute decision-making processes; and

Whereas undergraduates value their level of involvement throughout the previous phases of the Institute-wide planning process; and

Whereas administrators should fully understand the undergraduate viewpoint before any final budget cuts are implemented;

Be it resolved, by the Undergraduate Association assembled in Senate:

That forums open to students continue to be held to discuss final proposals, particularly those which will affect the undergraduate population, before they are implemented; and

That student representatives be included in the Project Teams, which will further research and investigate many of the recommendations mentioned in the Institute-wide Planning Task Force's Report; and

That the MIT senior leadership provide the MIT community with explanations of the reasoning behind the budget decisions ultimately selected for implementation.
