Hazards Identification

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW : Corrosive. Causes burns. Reacts violently with water. Combustible liquid. HEALTH: 3 FLAMMABILITY: 0 REACTIVITY: 0

First Aid Measures

ORAL EXPOSURE: If swallowed, wash out mouth with water provided person is conscious. Call a physician immediately.

INHALATION EXPOSURE: If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen.

EYE EXPOSURE: Assure adequate flushing of the eyes by separating the eyelids with fingers.

Accidental Release Measures

PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED IN CASE OF LEAK OR SPILL: Evacuate area. PROCEDURE(S) OF PERSONAL PRECAUTION(S): Wear self-contained breathing apparatus, rubber boots, and heavy rubber gloves.

METHODS FOR CLEANING UP: Absorb on sand or vermiculite and place in closed containers for disposal. Ventilate area and wash spill site after material pickup is complete.

Handling and Storage

HANDLING

User Exposure: Do not breathe vapor. Do not get in eyes, on skin, on clothing. Avoid prolonged or repeated exposure.

STORAGE

Suitable: Keep tightly closed. Keep away from heat and open flame. Store in a cool dry place.

Incompatible Materials: Do not allow contact with water
