When Ananias heard this, he fell down and died. And great fear seized all who heard what had happened" (Acts 5 : 1-5). All sin must go, all rebellion must go, all independence must go, all hypocrisy must go, all slander must go and the fear of the Lord must rule the day and then it will become the day of My power.

Those who want to be filled with the Holy Spirit and His power in full measure should use the book "Be filled with the Holy Spirit" to identify the idols and sins in their hearts and, while fasting, pull out each idol, one after another (fasting softens the heart and puts the heart in a condition in which its idols can be pulled down easily and its sins uprooted easily). No-one should ask why We have not filled him with the Holy Spirit and His power in full measure until he or she has gone through the book, working on the heart through the light shining from the book twelve times. There shall be a first going through the book which is most painful, and the heart of the sincere shall be broken with grief for having lived with a heart that was so evil. The first reading of the book and working on the heart shall also take the longest time to go through. Then there shall be a second reading with a second working on the heart. During the second reading things that were not seen and, consequently, not dealt with at the first reading will be dealt with. Then there shall be a third, a fourth, a fifth, a sixth, a seventh and perhaps an eighth, ninth, tenth, eleventh and twelfth reading. At the end of each reading after the seventh, the reader should ask the Lord if He is satisfied with his heart. If the Lord is satisfied, the person should then ask to be filled

with the Holy Spirit and he will be filled to overflowing. Another way to handle the matter is to keep going through the book with prayer and fasting and the uprooting of idols and the confession and forsaking of all sin until one goes through the book and finds that there is nothing coming up for him to deal with. When a person gets there, he is ready and, on asking simply, the Holy Spirit will come upon him in power and he will be filled with the Holy Spirit and His power in full measure, and a new day will dawn on him in every domain of his life, and he will never be the same. Following such filling with the Holy Spirit and His power in fullness, what could not be done in the winning of the lost and in other areas of the Christian walk in one year could be done in one week. Things that could not be done in a life time of service will become common place events and accomplishments. It will be a new day! A new day! A new day!!! It will be the power of the Holy Spirit!
