

This story is written in a language that has evolved from Chaotic, the language of Kevin Wald's puzzle [Son of the Realm of Unspeakable Chaos](#), by the following regular sound changes, in order:

1. Delete every D, and the word's next letter if it's a vowel and the word has at least two.
2. Delete final vowels of multisyllabic words.
3. After a consonant, A/O/U make the preceding consonant labial/alveolar/velar, respectively.
4. Vowel raising: A->O->ʊ->Aʊ, E->I->Y->EY (as in the English [Great Vowel Shift](#))
5. Defrication after high vowels (e.g. YH-YK, ʊZ-ʊD).
6. Devoice voiced stops, and aspirate already voiceless ones.

(In some cases, other orders of these rules work---for instance, one could move rule 5 earlier and modify it to "defrication after non-low vowels".)

Letters have their IPA / typical English values, except that w is IPA/English v and h is IPA x. The letters l and r are unaffected by those rules. The complete set of consonants is:

(labial/alveolar/velar)

Nasals: m/n/ŋ

Stops (voiced, voiceless, aspirated): b/d/g, p/t/k, pʰ/tʰ/kʰ

Fricatives (voiced, voiceless): w/z/ɣ, f/s/h

l, r

Applying those sound changes to the answer to Son of the Realm of Unspeakable Chaos, d̥ulowudozudʊ, gives lowuzʊ, then lowuz, then loyuz, then luyaʊz, then lugaud, then lukaut, or LOOKOUT, which is also what Professor Plum (character inspired by [Vaarsuvius](#)) instructed people to do to avoid being killed by the dragon.

The texts in phouthyk^h, Chaotic, and English follow. The Chaotic version invents six new words and two bits of morphology, which aren't uniquely reconstructible from the puzzle, but one possibility is:

GRY: when

IMY: if

BRY: how

AZONA: same

TYLOP: know

WANUB: help

to make the future/imperative forms of a verb, make the last vowel front and add a copy of the original vowel to the beginning.

to make a noun into the associated verb, make the last vowel front and add zVt, where V is a copy of the original vowel.

mospbos: uthydr *zyn*. mo y khaulul-FABULA, um uthr thulokphoytutut.

thulokphoytutot: ni lluk khaululomeythuluky, um ukhaululozyth fy FABULA-lluk---REKURSIWUM, ukh! IMPRIMIS ni fy FABULA-lluk KAOTIKA-ri, phouthyk-PROAWUS. ym theyluph zy KAOTIKA phey mo INTELLIGENTIA wo mpos, um theyluph zy phouthyk. ozun, ym theyluph zy SOLUTIO su, um theyluph zy SOLUTIO u.

ploks: khaunjauspboroth. auponeyrp FABULA wo yn.

hauls: mo DRAKO khaulul-PEKUNIA, um mo fy thifoauruth.

moposeynphokmophorkhis: ofytul y mok phey reyl phey pleyk phey haul yaar thifoauruth. ofytul fy haul phey mok omilor thifoauruth. ofytul mospbos plik phey mosth phey haul phowophorokhaul thifoauruth phey nulnk mok phey ril ropor thifoauruth phey thulokphoytutut haul phey mosth ropor thifoauruth phey ploks mopor pleyk phros auth thifoauruth.

thulokphoytutut: (meyluph fy ploks phow-DRAKO-ri, khey thrur.) ukh! fytul yn ozun thinfoauryth, weym KARAKTER-FABULA ozun phonzutth, khey mo haul nuln phey nuln haul. khey ni lluk krumothyth (zuphoyaunulhaul), um uthr lluk thinfoauryth ozun, uthr phonzutth ozun.

ploks: ooh! auponeyp! (luhauveloyauth DRAKO fy.)

thulokphoytutut: thry y. ukh! weym ploks phozutth-D FABULA-llukir, phey luhauveloyauth LINGUA o D, um theylyp y auluhauzeloyeth DRAKO fy! mo... phlokausz y "mo". ni ploks phozutthukhaul u. khey mo LINGUA o luhauvel-D-SYLLABA ozun, ozun mo polokhsy luhauelphozutthukhaul. lun thry y, thry ploks, um auluhauzeloyeth DRAKO y. iaurikh! mo omoleythyth u jauphroseyl phey rop. (luhauveloyauth DRAKO fy.)

blagse: mylorp din *DRAKO!* nea fi paradeisoszoologikosre, ky nar fi! arusem din!

podolagpaidogogos: (mylop fi *DRAKO KAELEM*re.) na fi *AENIGMA*---fry na *DRAKO*, py bry aner din panzostisuldi? tylop di kumora, omy na *INTELLIGENTIA* da megas, omy tylop di *SOLUTIO-AENIGMA. RE WERA*, na *SOLUTIO* do azono, na *SOLUTIO-FABULA*-dulloge azono, ky *TRANSPOSITA*. tylop zin *FABULA*-dulloge? nea fi tulola-ASTRONAUTA (tulolatrowowoda)...hmm, mylorp di wonde, imy na DR...

moldange: otrird zi. bry mylorp zi *DRAKO?* na zi zopa? na fi *DRAKO* megas!

suldase: otrird *zi*. afigoled din *DRAKO* lony lokulazut *DRAKO* din wy stir.

nastase: otrird *zin*. na di tulola-*FABULA*, omy otrid podolagpaidogogos.

podolagpaidogogos: nea dulloe tulolamytologia, omy otulolazit fi *FABULA*-dulloge---*REKURSIWUM*, oho! *IMPRIMIS* nea fi *FABULA*-dulloge *KAOTIKA*-re, kaotika-*PROAWUS*. imy tylop zi *KAOTIKA* py na *INTELLIGENTIA* za megas, omy tylop zi kaotika. azona, imy tylop zi *SOLUTIO* fo, omy tylop zi *SOLUTIO* do.

blagse: tumuparatu. uwanyrb *FABULA* za din.

suldase: na *DRAKO* tulola-*PEKUNIA*, omy na fi tesaurosre.

magasyntagmatarkes: afigoled di magy py dryl py blyg py suldy zudure tesauros. afigoled fi sulde py mage amelare tesauros. afigoled nastase bleg py neste py sulde tawaparature tesauros py moldange mage py drel rabare tesauros py podolagpaidogogos sulde py neste rabare tesauros py blagse magare blyg prasu ut tesauros.

podolagpaidogogos: (mylop fi blagse tawa-*DRAKO*-re, ky trord.) oho! figolad din azono tensauris, wymu *KARAKTER-FABULA* azono panzosti, ky na sulda moldan py moldan sulda. ky nea dulloe dikromatikos (zopawudomoldansulda), omy otrid dulloe tensauris azona, otrid panzosti azona.

blagse: aah! uwanyb! (lokulazut *DRAKO* fi.)

podolagpaidogogos: trido di. oho! wymu blagse pazosto-*D FABULA*-dullogere, py lokulazut *LINGUA* da *D*, omy tylipo di ulokulazyt *DRAKO* fi! na... plagurz di "na". nea blagse pazostosulda do. ky na *LINGUA* da lokula-*D-SYLLABA* azona, azona na galaksia lokulapazostosulda. lony trido di, trido blagse, omy ulokulazyt *DRAKO* di. eureka! na analysis do danuprasyl py raba. (lokulazut *DRAKO* fi.)

English

Mrs. Peacock: We can't find the dragon! It was in the zoo, but it's not there! We're going to die!

Professor Plum: (sees the dragon in the sky.) This is a puzzle---where is the dragon, and how can we not be redshirts? I know science, so my intelligence is huge, so I know the solution to the puzzle. In fact, the solution is the same as the solution to the story of Mr. Boddy, but transposed. Do y'all know the story of Mr. Boddy? He was an astronaut-fan (fan of sailors of stars)...hmm, I don't see the stars, because there's a dr...

Mr. Green: Shut up. How can you not see the dragon? Are you blind? It's a huge dragon!

Ms. Scarlet: *You* shut up. Let's search for the dragon before the dragon kills us or anyone.

Mrs. White: *Both of you* shut up. I'm a fan of stories, so let Professor Plum speak.

Professor Plum: Mr. Boddy was a fan of mythology, so he would have loved the story of Mr. Boddy---recursive, oho! Originally the story of Mr. Boddy was in Chaotic, the ancestor of p^hou^thyk^h. If you know Chaotic and your intelligence is huge, then you know p^hou^thyk^h. The same way, if you know its solution, then you know our solution.

Mrs. Peacock: BS. Your story won't help us.

Ms. Scarlet: The dragon is a money-lover, so it's in a vault.

Colonel Mustard: I'll search the yellow and black and blue and red divided X-wise vault. You search the red and yellow divided /-wise vault. Mrs. White, search the blue and white and red divided bullseye-wise vault; Mr. Green, the yellow and black, divided +-wise vault; Professor Plum, the red and white divided +-wise vault; and Ms. Peacock the yellow with a blue horizontal stripe vault.

Professor Plum: (sees Mrs. Peacock in the dragon's eye, but doesn't say.) Oho! We're searching the same vaults as the characters of the story were wearing shirts, but with red green and green red. But Mr. Boddy was dichromatic (red-green colorblind), so Mr. Boddy would have said that the vaults are the same as the shirts.

Mrs. Peacock: Aah! Help! (The dragon kills her.)

Professor Plum: I told you so. Oho! Mrs. Peacock was wearing a D-shirt in the story of Mr. Boddy, and our language kills Ds, so I knew that the Dragon would kill her! She is... I don't mean "is". Mrs. Peacock was our redshirt. And our language is a D-syllable-killer the same way that the galaxy is a redshirt-killer. Before I spoke, Mrs. Peacock spoke, so the dragon will kill me. Eureka! My analysis is A+. (The dragon kills him.)
