

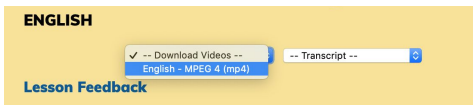
Note: It is highly recommended to download BLOSSOMS videos rather than streaming.

The steps below allow you to easily follow steps to either download (or stream if needed) your BLOSSOMS video through Chrome/Safari/Firefox.

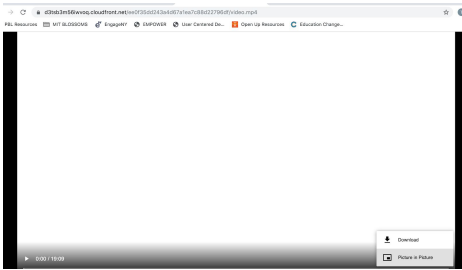
Google Chrome

To download with Google Chrome:

1. Choose your BLOSSOMS video which opens to the video page.
2. In the center of the page, click “**Download Videos**” and choose “**English - MPG 4 (mp4)**”

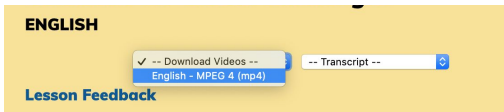


3. On the lower-right hand corner, click on the 3 dots and choose “Download”:

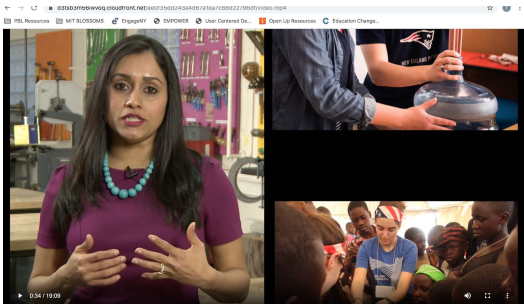


To stream with Google Chrome:

1. Open your BLOSSOMS video
2. Click on “Download Videos” and choose “English - MPG 4 (mp4)”



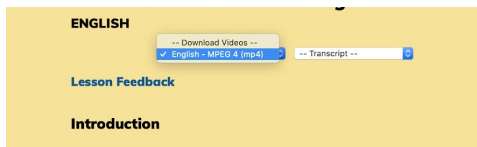
3. This now opens a new web browser below. Click the play button. In this example, we chose to stream the User-Centered Design lesson.



Safari

To download with Safari:

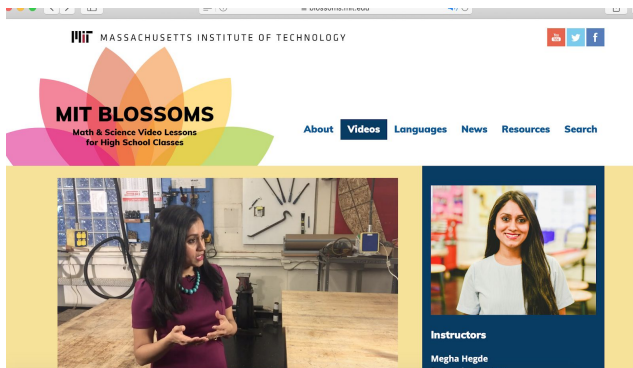
1. Choose your BLOSSOMS video which opens to the video page.
2. Click on the Download Videos link and choose English - MPEG 4 (mp4)



To stream with Safari:

1. Choose your BLOSSOMS video which opens to the video page.
2. Click on the play button and the video begins.

Firefox:

To stream with Firefox:

1. Choose your BLOSSOMS video which opens to the video page.
2. Click on the Download Videos link and choose English - MPEG 4 (mp4).
