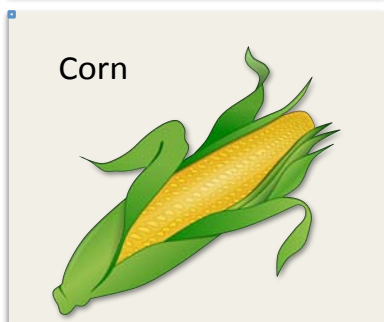
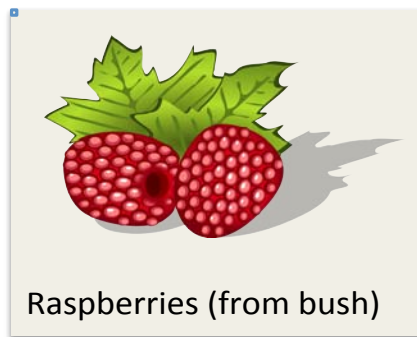
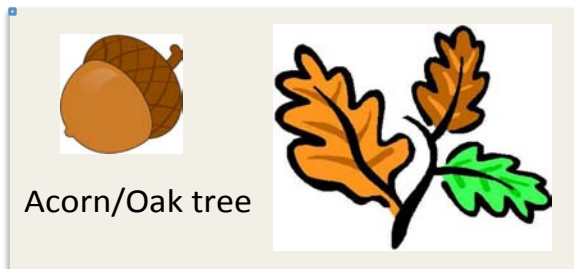
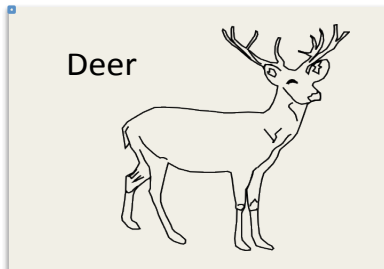


Build a 17th Century New England Food Web
