<b>Statement of Problem (5)</b>	Only one problem was chosen. Problem is not described clearly.	Two problems were chosen from the same category. Problem is not described clearly. At least one problem was created by the student.
<b>Research Information (10)</b>	Irrelevant or incomplete information is listed.	Some information is determined, but some critical information is missing.	The information necessary for solving the problem is determined and listed clearly.	The necessary information for solving the problem is determined and explained completely.
<b>Calculations (10)</b>	Calculations are incomplete or contain many mistakes. Units are not labeled.	Most of the calculations are correct, but there may be a few mistakes. Some units are left out.	The calculations are done correctly and clearly written out with units labeled.	The calculations are done correctly and clearly written out with units labeled. Answers are rounded to the correct number of significant figures.
<b>Illustrations (10)</b>	Illustrations are missing from the poster.	Not enough illustrations are provided or are not relevant to the problem.	Illustrations relate to the problem and are helpful in understanding the solution to the problem.	Illustrations are beautifully drawn or created by the student and relate to the problem.
<b>Poster Design (10)</b>	Poster is messy or poorly designed.	The poster is reasonably attractive, but lacking in color or neatness.	The poster is attractive in terms of design, layout, and neatness. It is well organized and easy to read.	Exceptionally attractive in design and layout. Overall project is eye-catching and shows attention to detail.
<b>Bibliography (5)</b>	Bibliography is incomplete or haphazardly organized and formatted. Many citations are incomplete or missing.	Bibliography is fairly well organized and formatted. Some citations are incomplete or missing.	Bibliography is correctly organized and formatted. All literature/Internet and graphic sources are cited.	Bibliography is correctly organized and formatted. All literature/Internet and graphic sources are cited. Resources chosen indicate that information was validated by more than one source.
