# **Rhythms of the Season - Solution**

This puzzle looks like a bar-style crossword or cryptic, but the grid and numbering make no sense. The first realization is that each clue is comprised of random words from Christmas carol lyrics, as follows:

## Across

Bring us some tidings Citizens come adore angels Corncob silk and broomstick Eskimos roasting chestnuts Fire of fair green leaves Foggy Santa names games Follow jolly gay apparel Hills shone everywhere Nell will nick dolly Sleigh in bright open fields Soon holiday style will stop Soul felt thrill and pining Stephen, poor man, lay round

The next realization, as hinted by the flavor text, is that the bars in the grid indicate rhythms visually (independently in both across and down directions). Finding each carol's rhythm in the grid allows the assignment of each carol to a row or column:

Using the numbers in the grid to index into the carol titles, in grid order, yields the letters shown above, spelling a phrase in each direction: UTAH BBALL TEAM and NAG REPEATEDLY. These phrases clue the final two-word answer, **JAZZ HARP**.
