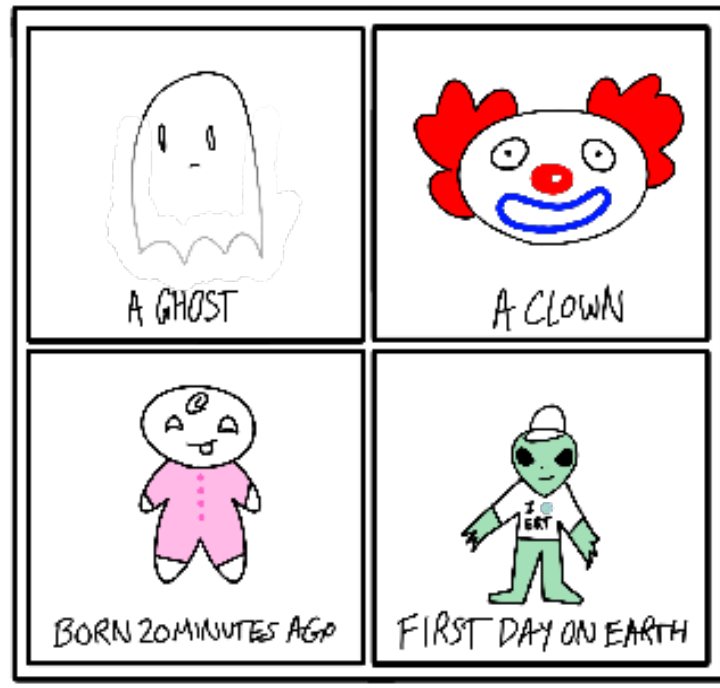

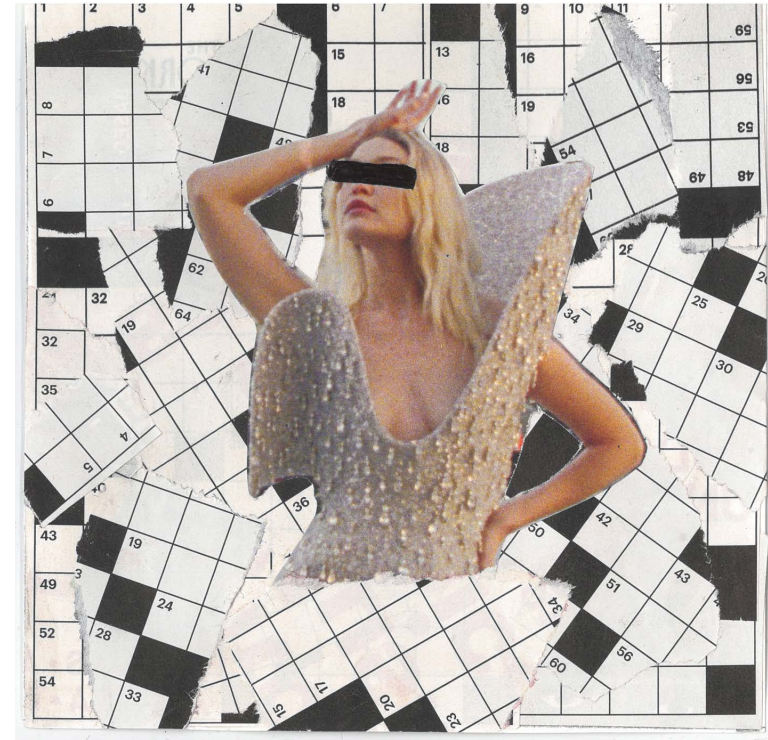

# MIT Bathroom Review

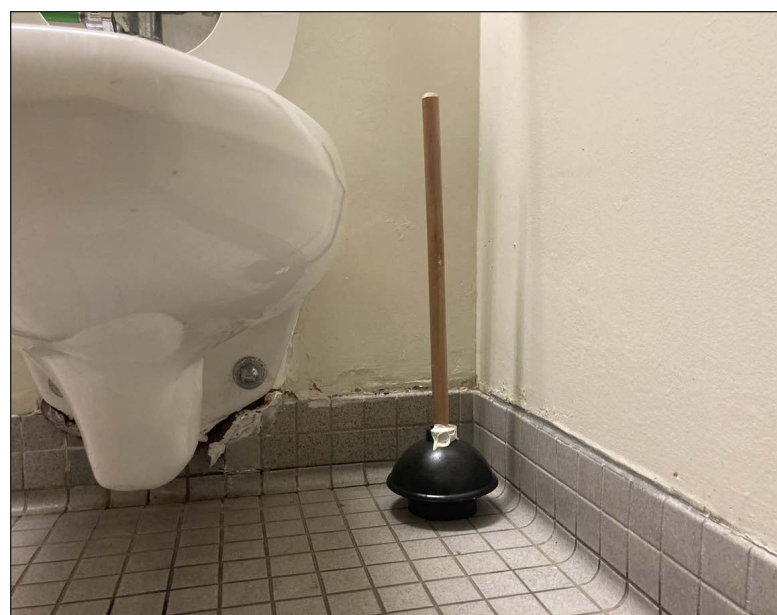
## 68-169

### STEP 4:

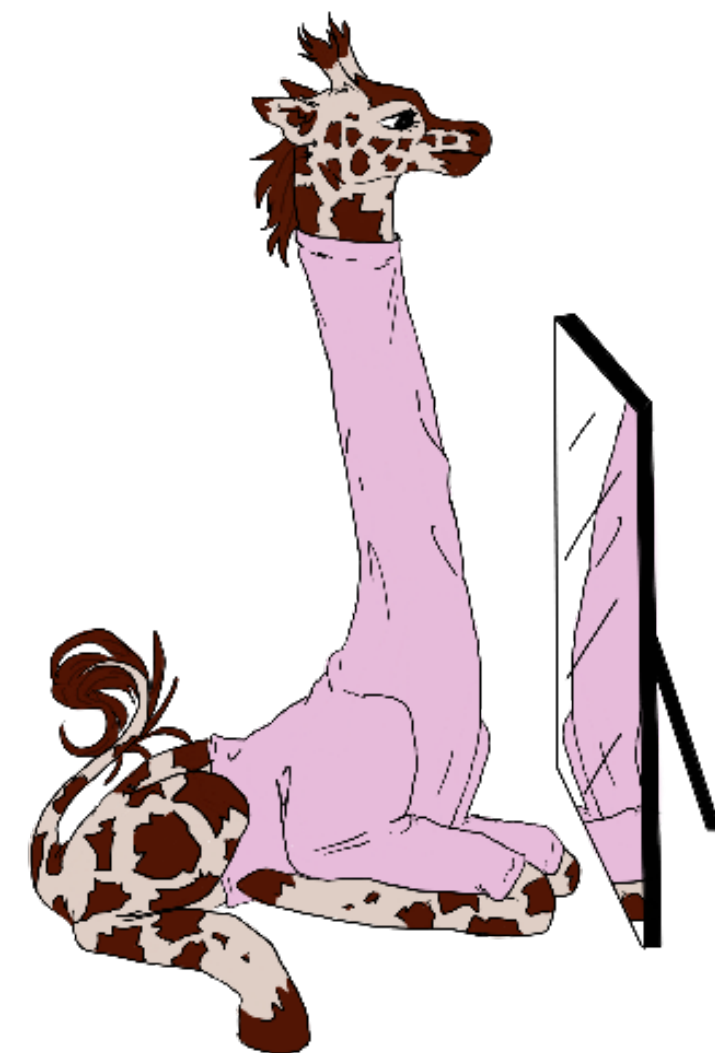
